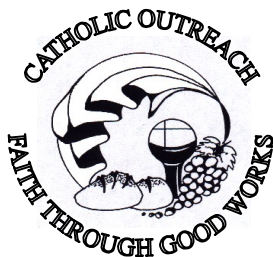

As Scott Peck once said, "The absence of conflict in a community is not a sign of health but a sign of death". The challenge for those in Christian ministry is to learn how to name conflict and address it in a way that is creative rather than destructive.

The seminar which is scripturally based, invites participants to come to a greater self understanding so that they may pursue their ministry more effectively. We will have the opportunity to reflect upon the attitudes and skills that need to be utilized when negative emotion is confronted. During the day participants will be invited to see their work in ministry as a manifestation of their relationship to God and part of their own journey in faith.
